The event is located in a parking lot, located across from 58 Watson Aviation Road, Greenville, SC 29607. This very special concert will benefit the Cancer Survivors Park Alliance. As a ticket holder, you are entitled to a parking space and an adjacent socializing space and can have up to 6 people in the vehicle (including the driver). The concert schedule is as follows:

ACCESS AND PARKING

Rock the Lot is located in the parking lot located across from 58 Watson Aviation Road, Greenville, SC 29607 (btw. The Blind Horse Saloon and the Greenville Convention Center). **We suggest you enter Watson Aviation Road via S. Pleasantburg/291. You will only be able to access the lot from Watson Aviation Road, not Lowndes Hill Road.** Upon arrival, we will check you and your guests in, and all will receive sponsor wristbands/21+ wristbands. Your vehicle will then be directed to your space as designated by your Tier level. Parking spaces are given on a first come, first serve



basis, according to Tier level. We will park rows from the center out. Gates open at 6pm.

A friendly reminder that this is a DRIVE-IN show. Your party must arrive together your vehicle. There is NOT designated parking off site for this event.
